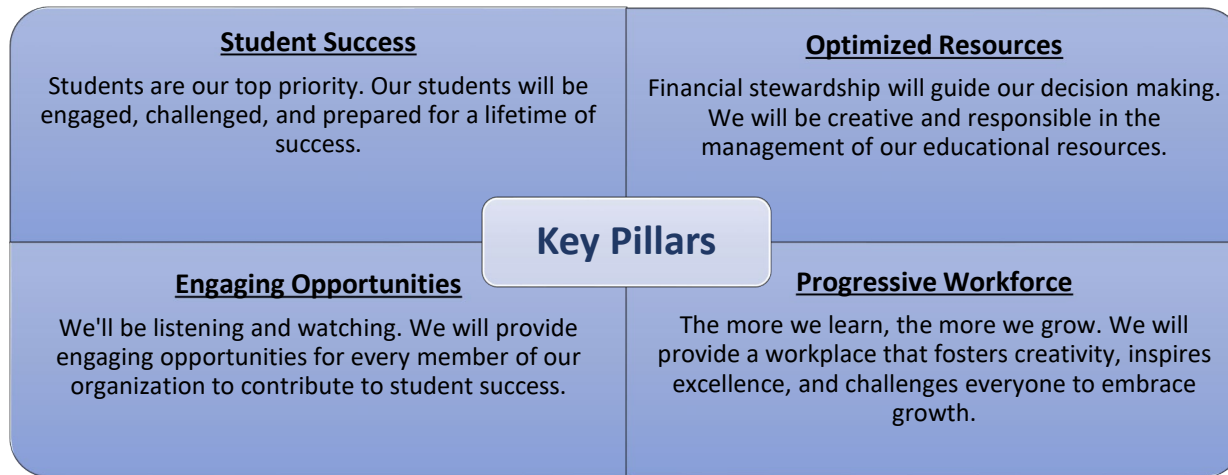


Secondary School Improvement Plan for Student Success
